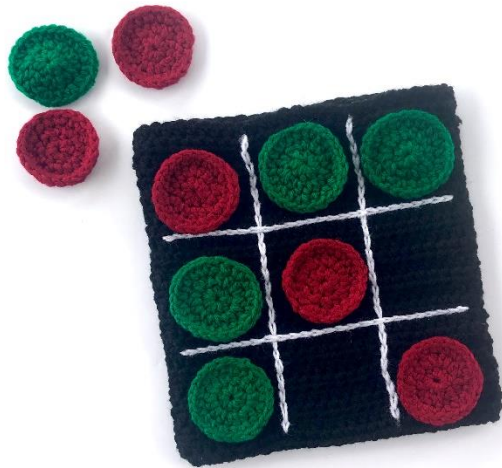




TRAVEL TIC TAC TOE BOARD

Crochet Pattern

This travel board game comes in handy while traveling in the car, waiting at the doctors, or just playing at home. Quick and easy to crochet, this game board also makes a wonderful gift for kids or adults. The front and back open up to house the game pieces and button close to make sure nothing is lost in traveling.

Travel Tic Tac Toe

Size: 9" x 9"

Materials

Yarn – Worsted Weight – acrylic or cotton, Sample = acrylic yarn (7 oz/364 yds)

Black, white, green, red or other holiday colors

Crochet Hook – Size H

Small black button, Yarn Needle

Yarn Required – Black (138 yds), White (~3 yds), Red/Green (26 yds each color)

Abbreviations:

ch – chain

st – stitches

sl st – slip stitch

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

hdc – half double crochet

sk – skip



Notes:

To increase or decrease the size of the game board, increase or decrease number of beginning stitches in multiples of 3. Then increase the number of rows to get the correct size desired.

Gauge: 3 hdc = 1", 2.6 rows = 1"

Directions - Font and Back - Make 2 - **Black yarn**

Row 1: Ch 29, starting in 3rd chain from hook, hdc in each st across row. Turn. (27 hdc)

Row 2: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc across row. Turn. (27 hdc)

Rows 3-24: Repeat Row 2

On back – make buttonhole on 2nd to last row.

Row 23: Ch 2, hdc in 1st 13 hdc, ch 1, sk 1 hdc, hdc to end of row. Turn.

Row 24: Ch 2, hdc in each hdc and ch1 space across row.

Finish off and weave in ends.

On Front – use white yarn to surface slip stitch vertical and horizontal lines.

For Vertical lines – mark line placement – counting from right to left, mark between stitch number 9 and 10, count 9 stitches again and mark placement between next 9 and 10th stitch. You should have 9 stitches to the left. Use white yarn and work a surface slip stitch straight up. Cut and knot at top on the underside and weave in ends. Repeat for second vertical line.

For Horizontal lines - mark line placement – counting from bottom to top of board, mark between rows 8 and 9 and between rows 16 and 17. Using white yarn, surface slip stitch between marked rows. Cut and knot at end of row on the underside and weave in ends. Repeat for second horizontal line.

Sewing

Lay front and back together with right sides facing out (there is no right/wrong side for the back). Using black yarn and a yarn needle, whip stitch sides together, starting at the top righthand corner and working around board to top left hand corner. Leave top open. Mark buttonhole position on back of front and sew on button.

Game Pieces – Use 2 colors (Red/Green), make 5 of each color

Work in the round – do NOT turn.

Rnd 1: Make a magic circle, ch 2, work 8 hdc in the circle, join with a sl st to 1st hdc. (8 hdc)

Rnd 2: Ch 2, starting in same st as sl st, work 2 hdc in each hdc, join with a sl st to 1st hdc. (16 hdc)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, starting in same st as sl st, *work 2 hdc in next hdc, 1 hdc in following stitch*, repeat *-* around, join with a sl st to 1st hdc. (24 hdc)

Finish off and weave in ends.

If your circles want to curl up, place a cloth over the circles and gently iron them until they will lay flat. Be very careful not to melt your yarn if you use acrylic yarn.

Store game pieces inside board and button shut when not in use.
